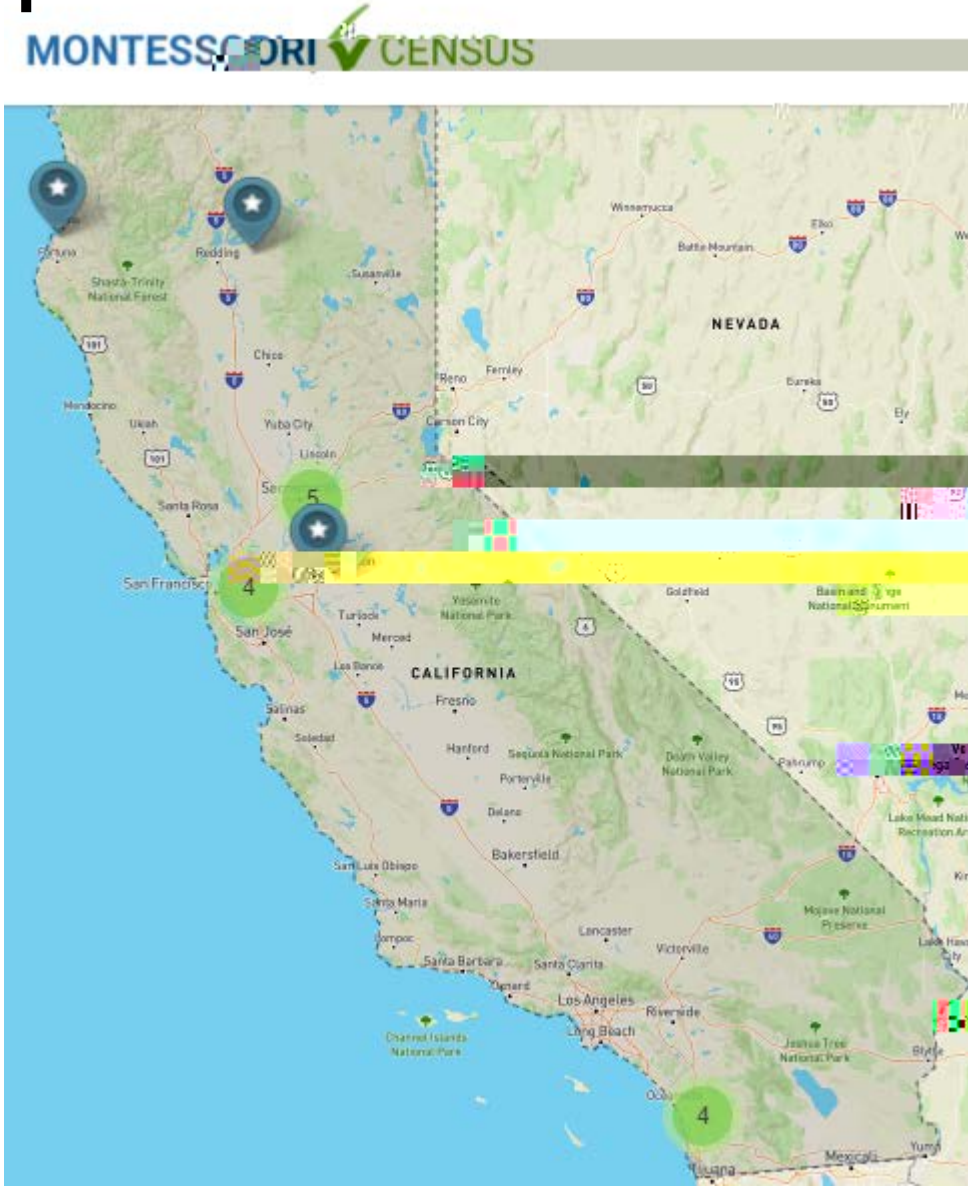


CMP Capitol's Unique Niche in the Sacramento City School Ecosystem

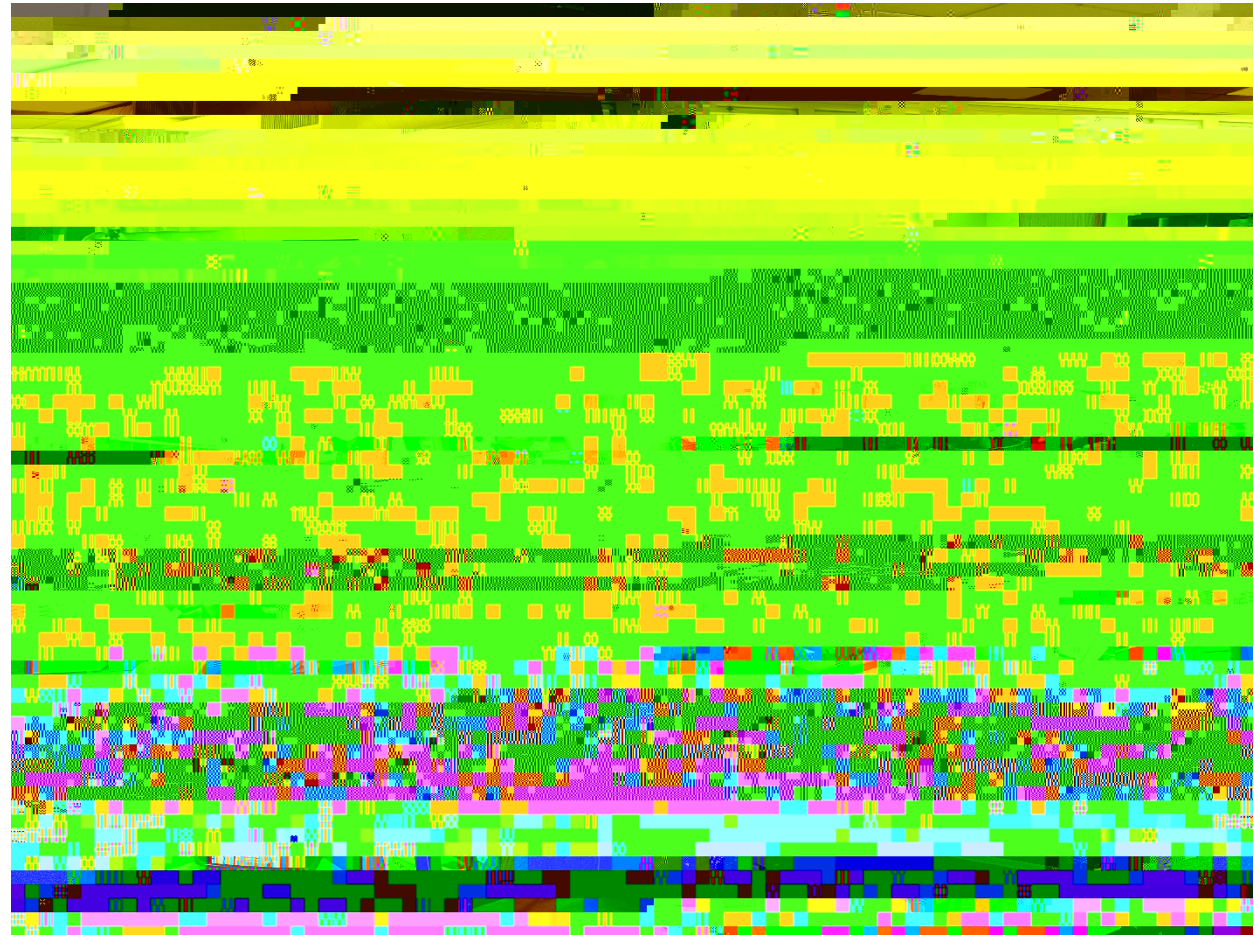
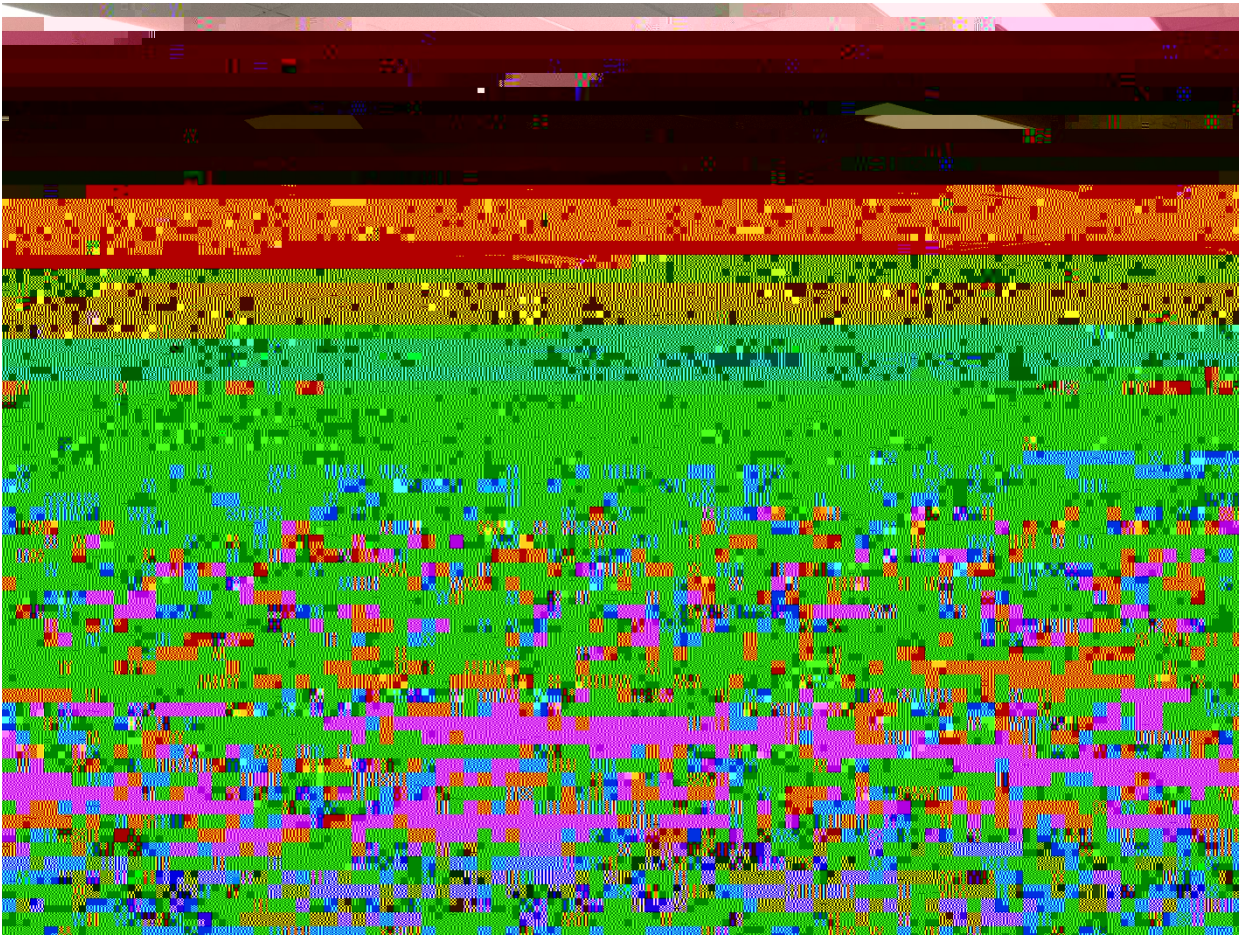
Mission Statement: The Mission of the California Montessori Project is to offer a quality, tuition-free Montessori Education that challenges our students to reach their full potential.

Free, public, Montessori schools are rare. According to the National Center for Montessori in the Public Sector there are only 16 public Montessori schools serving students K-8th grade in California.

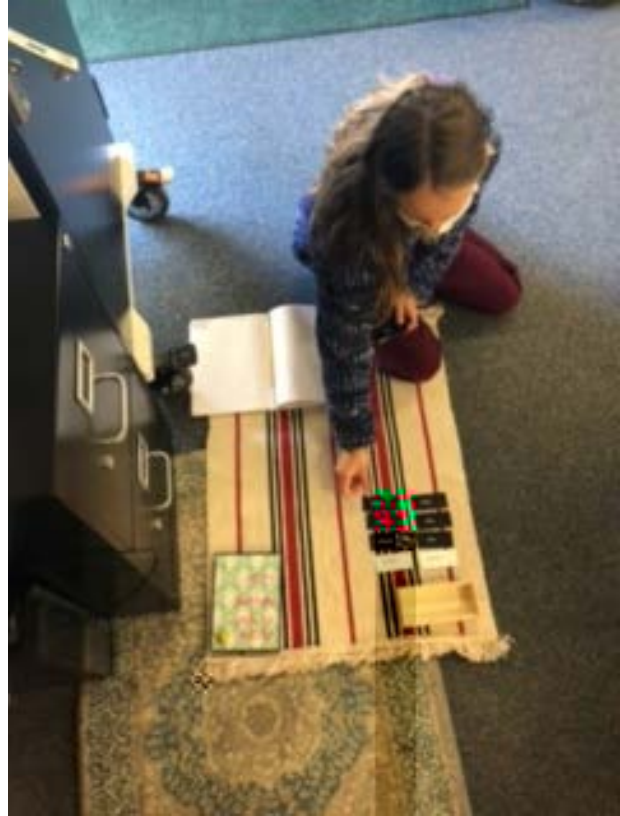
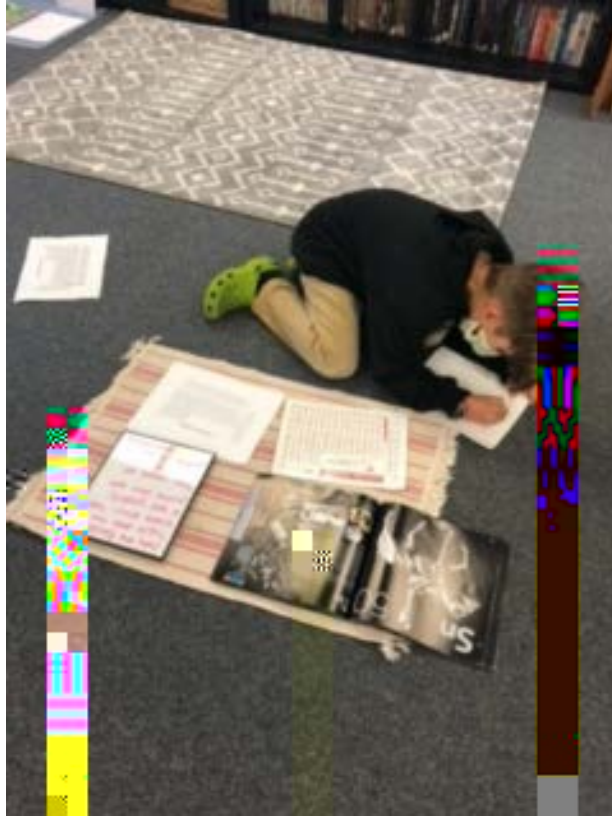

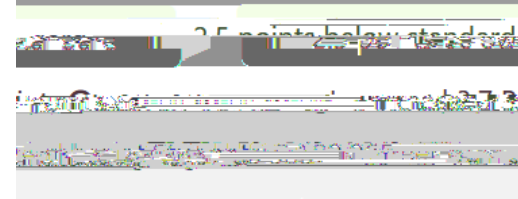

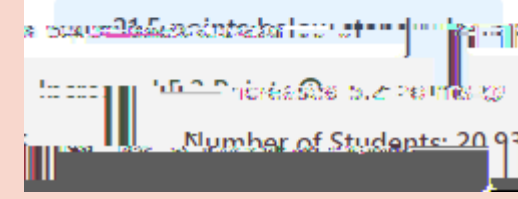

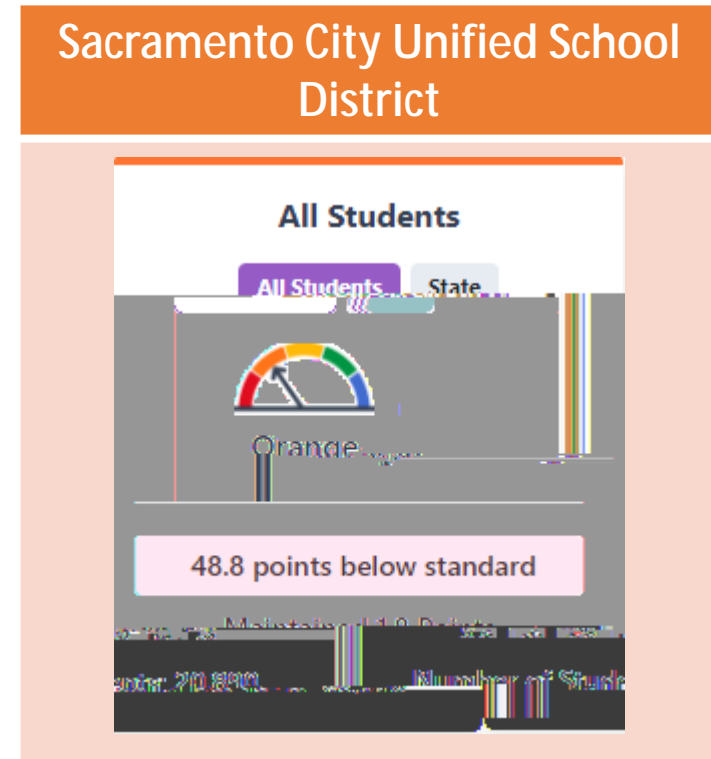

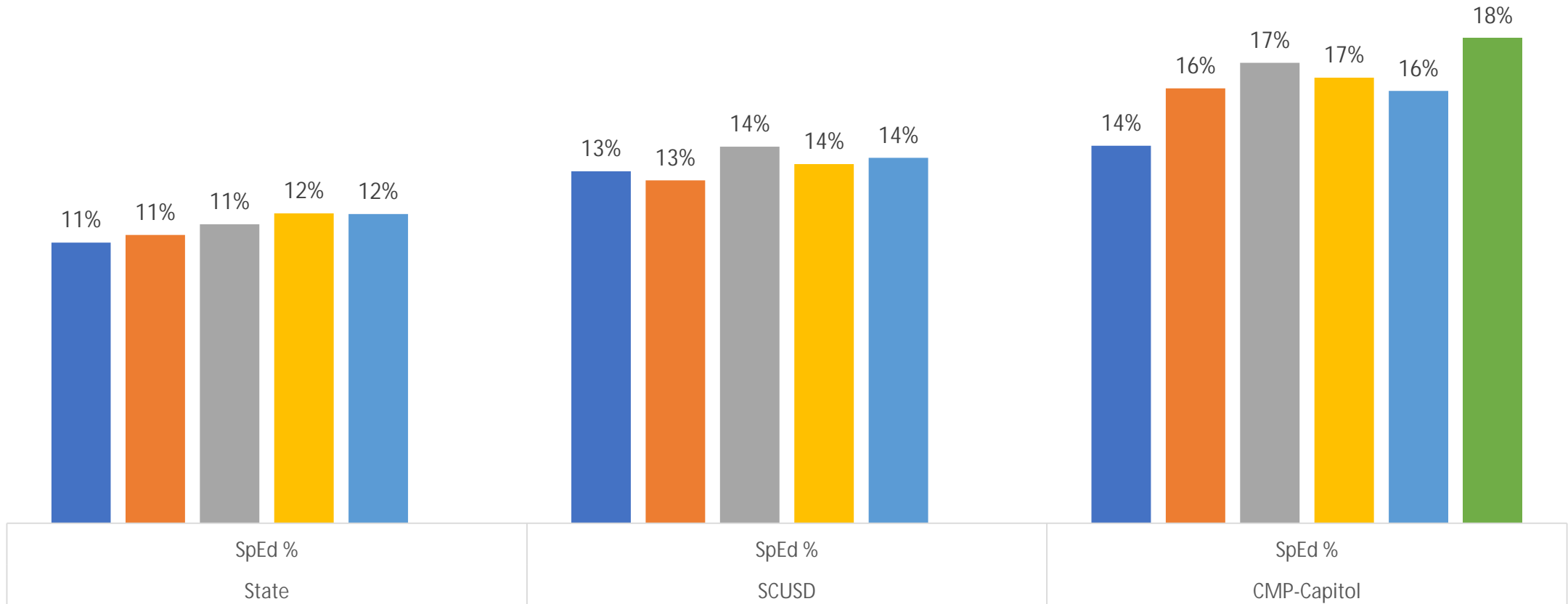

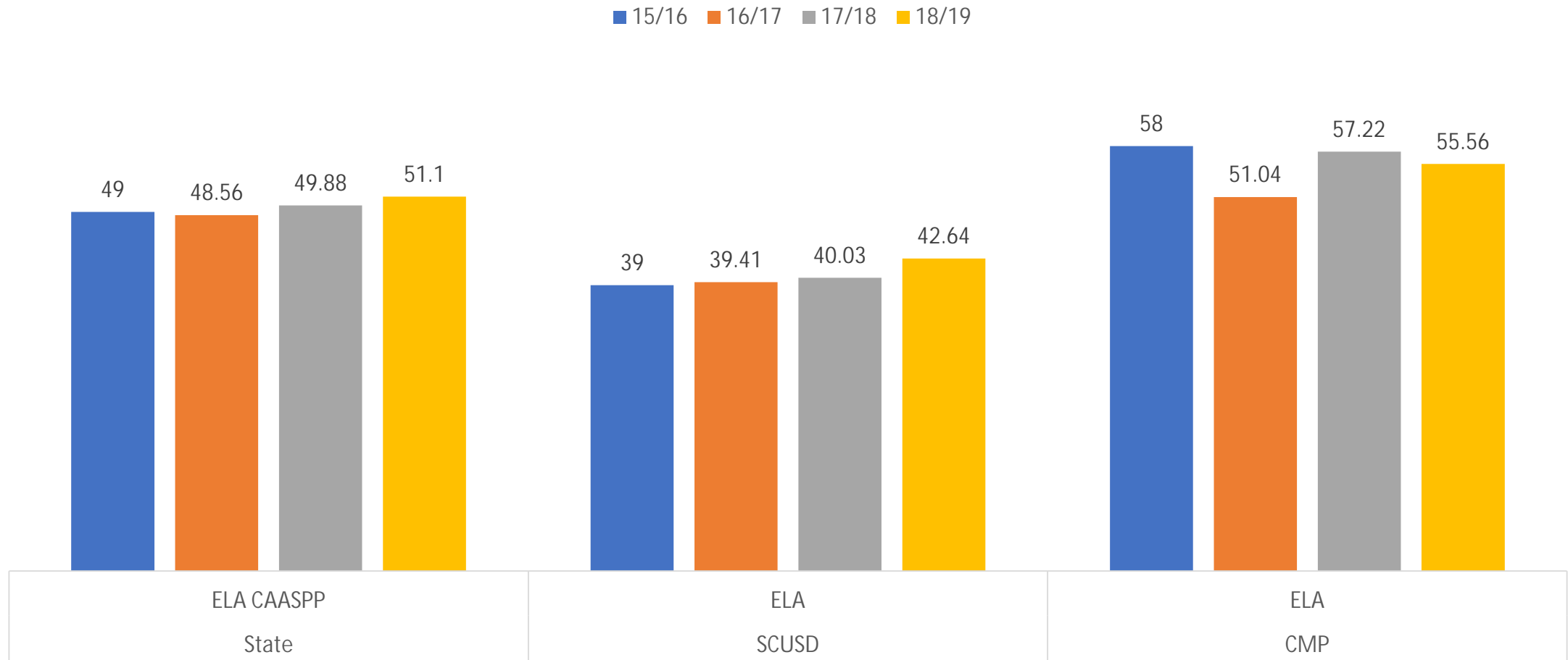
State, SCUSD, CMP-Capitol Student's With Disabilities Percentage of Student Population Comparison

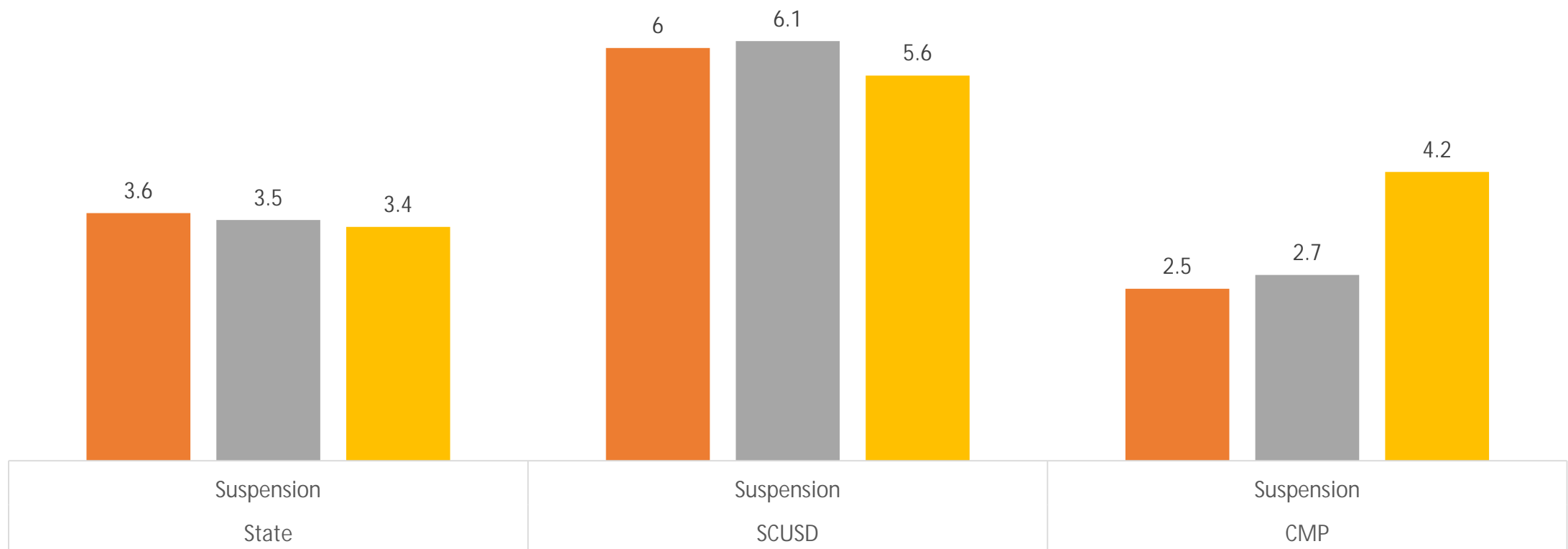
State/SCUSD/CMP CAASPP ELA Percent Proficient Multi-Year Comparison

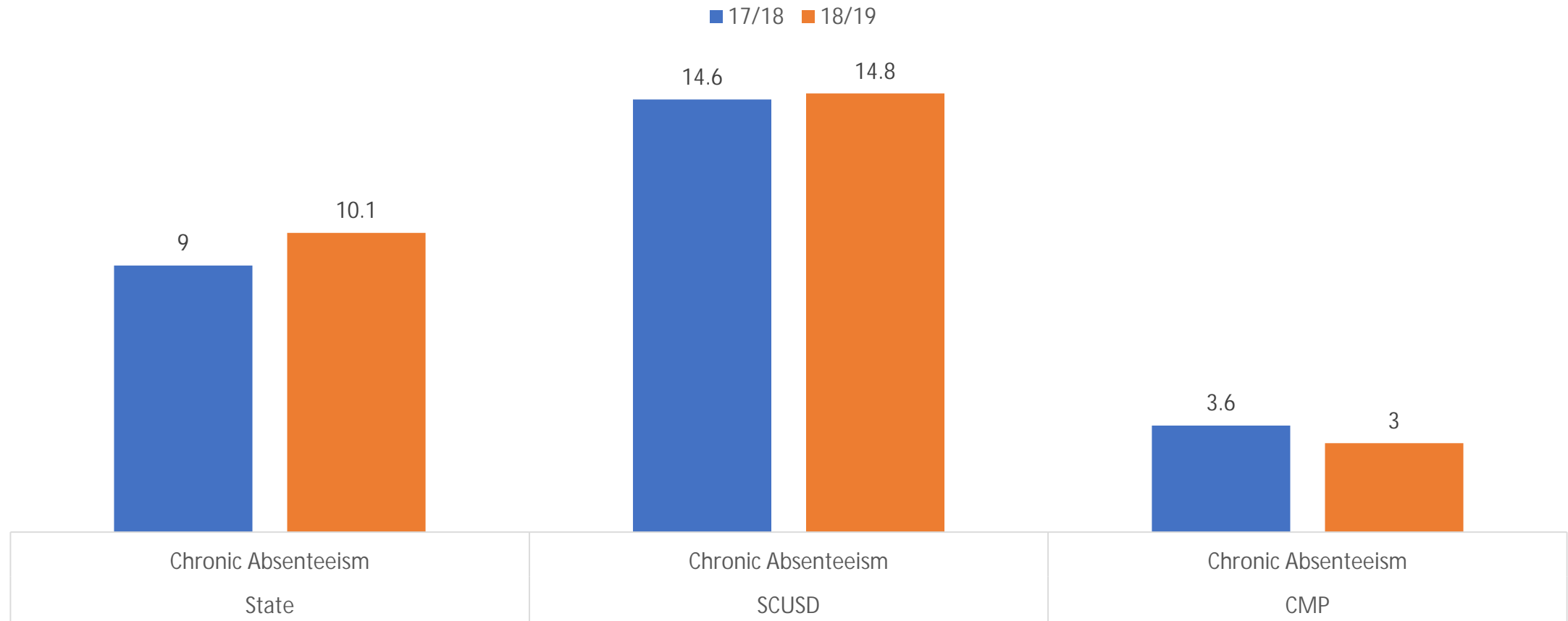

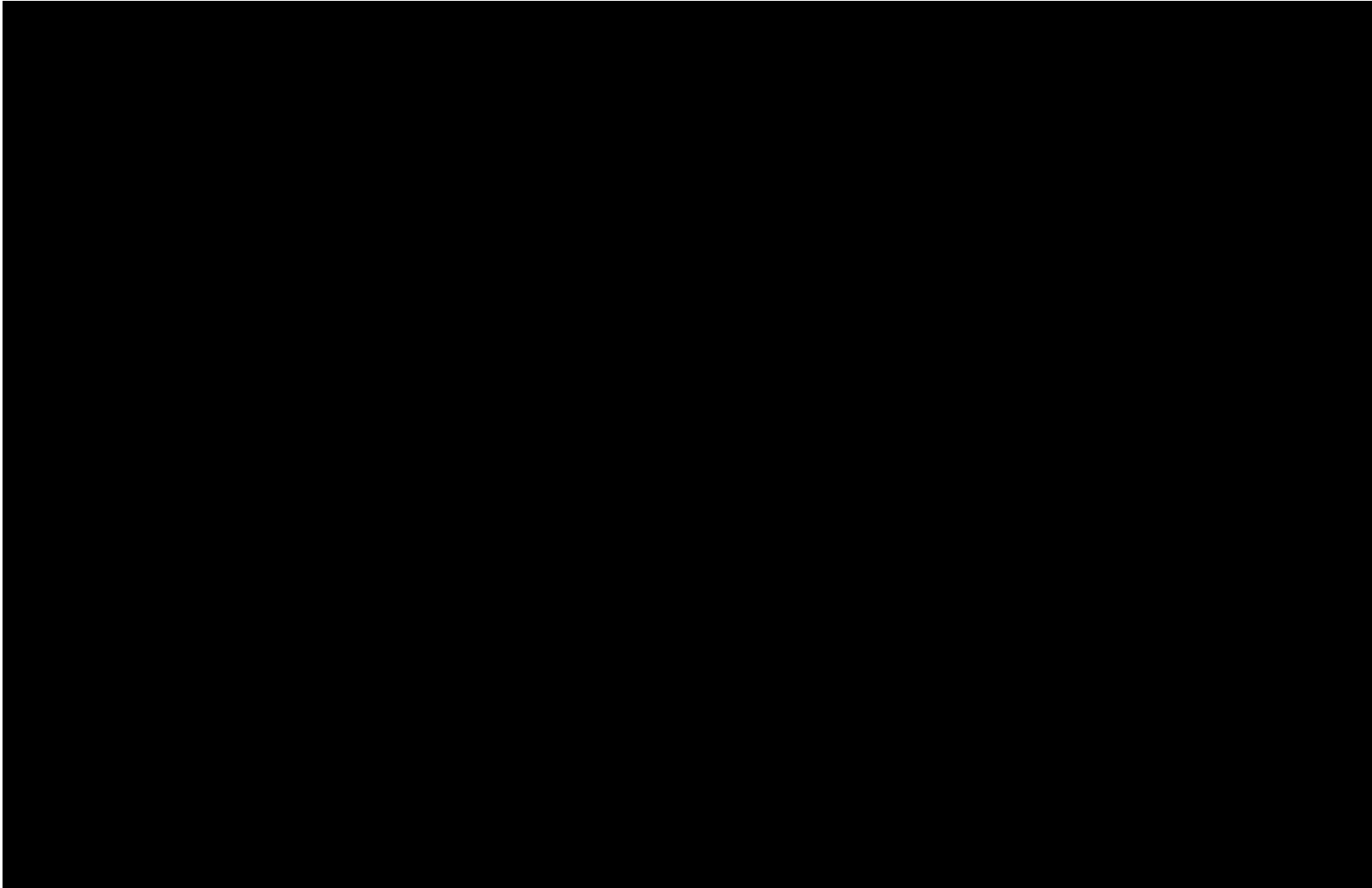

State/SCUSD/CMP Chronic Absenteeism Rate Multi-Year Comparison

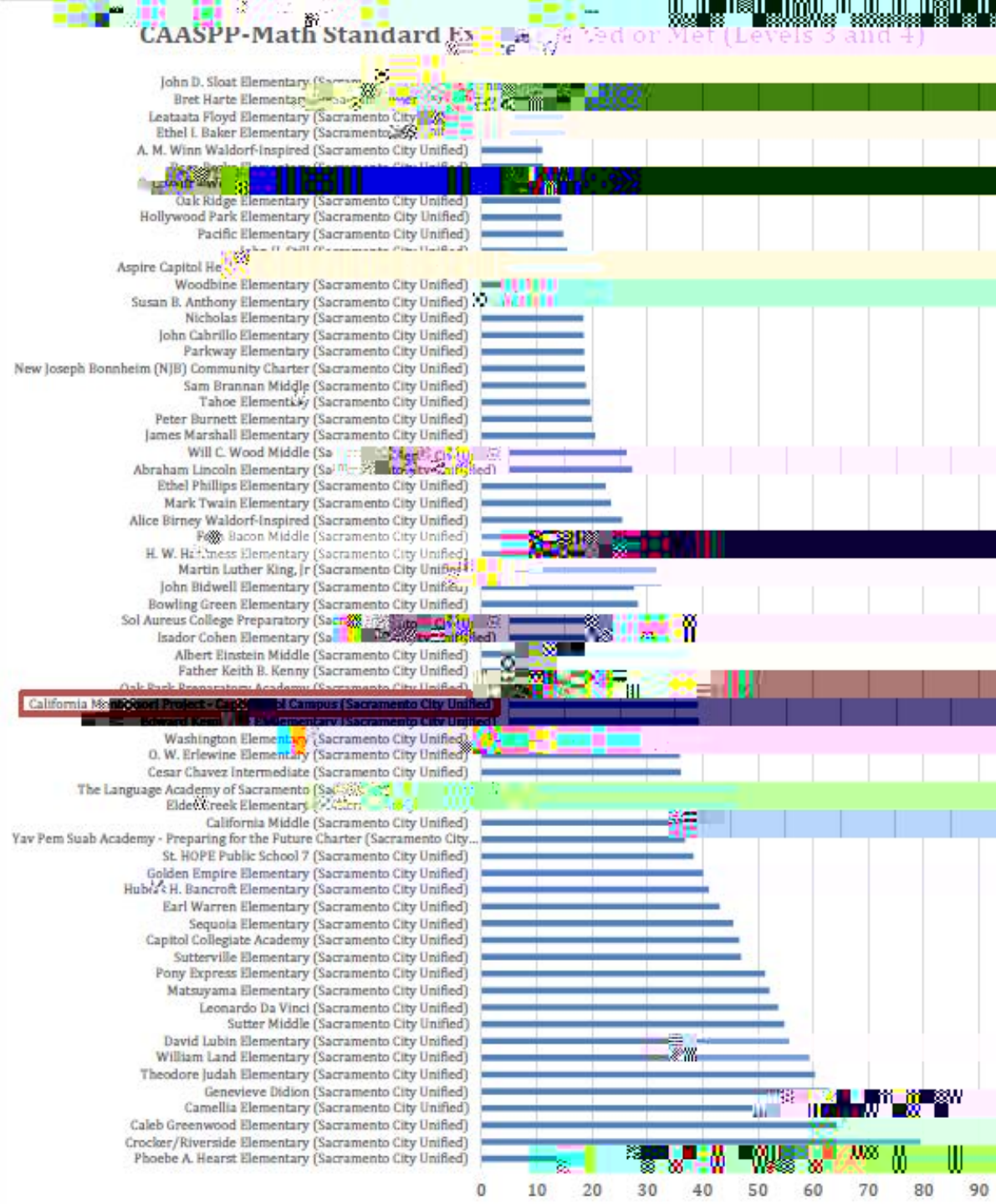

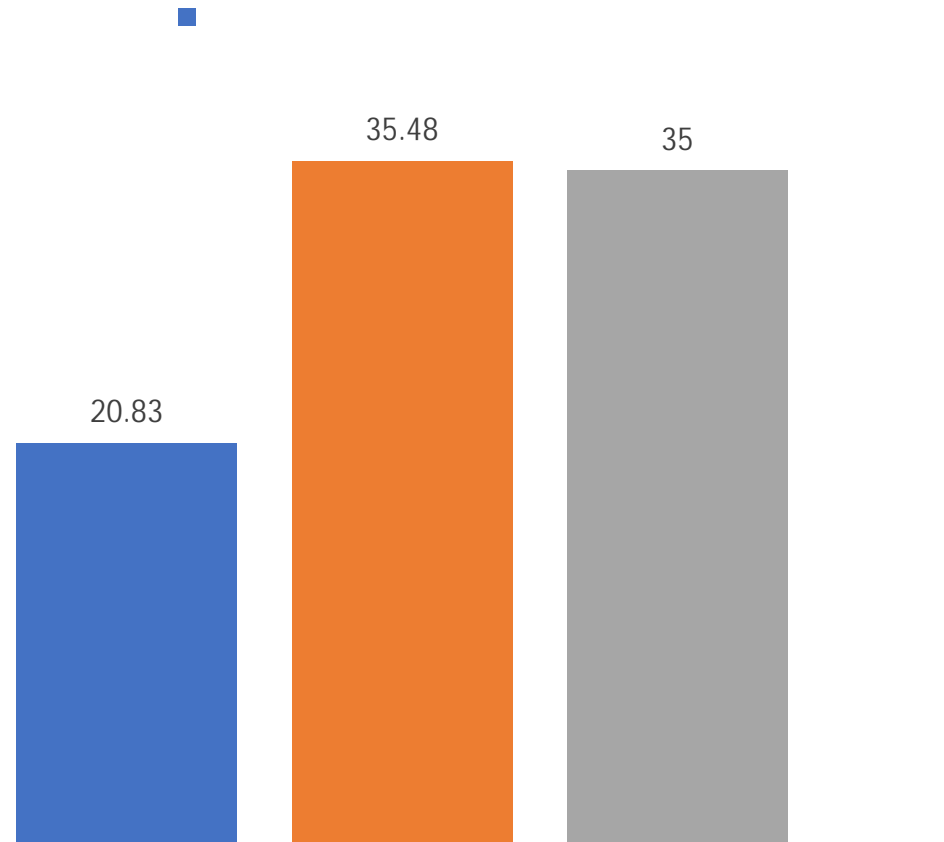

Proficient

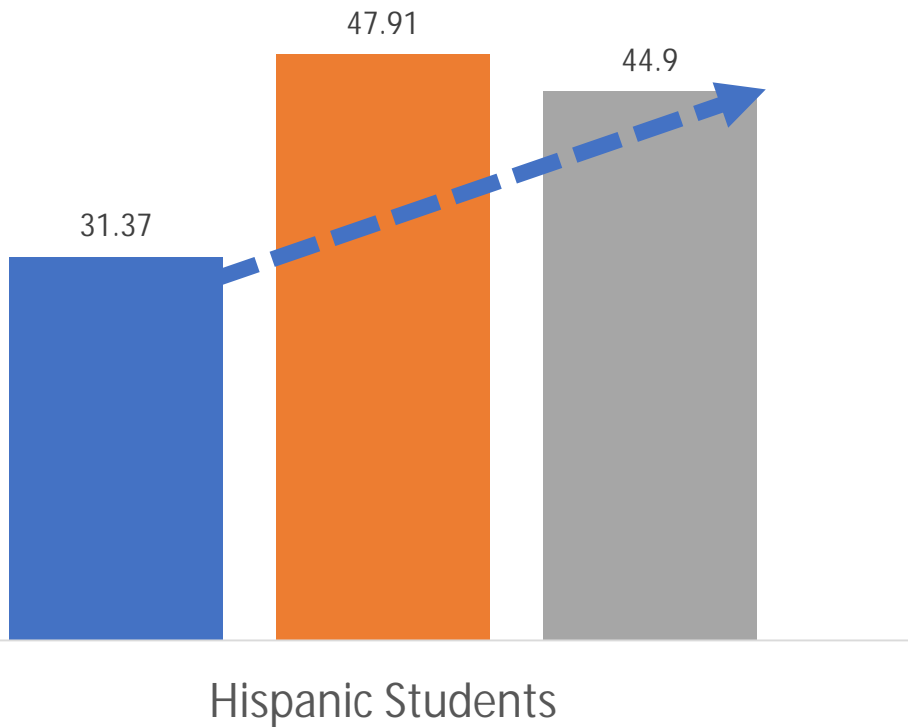

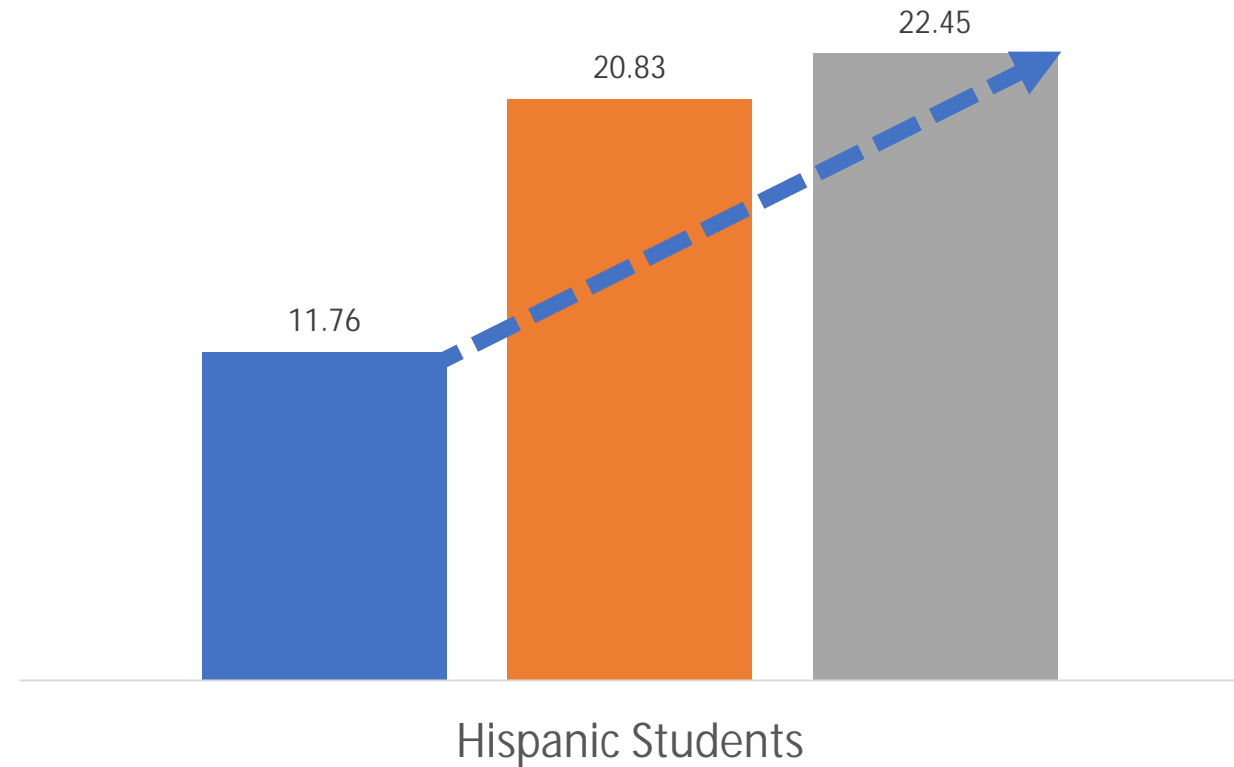
CMP - ELA CAASPP Growth in Percent Proficient

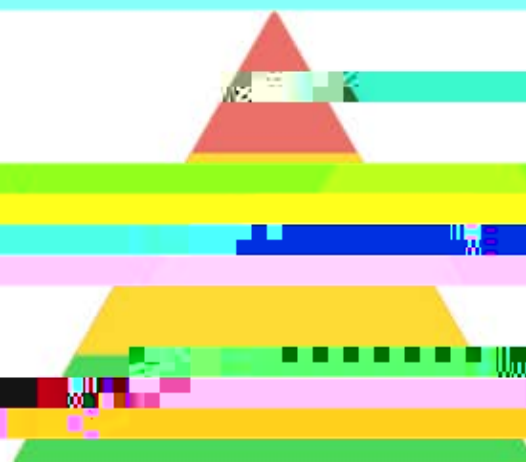
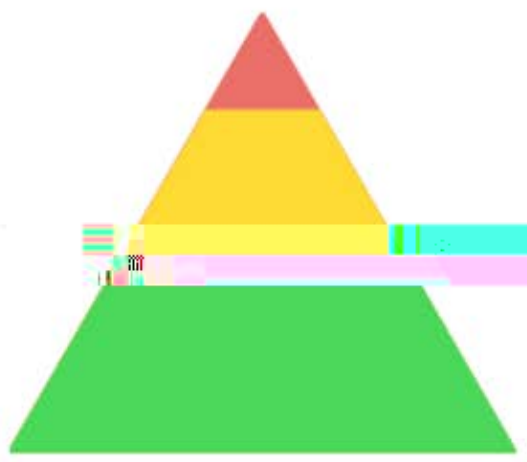
