Business and Noninstructional Operations

The Governing Board may accept agrift, grant, or bequest of money, property, or service to the district from any individual, private agency or organization, or other public agency that desires to support the district's educational program. While greatly appreciating suitable donations, t Board shall reject any gift which may directly or indirectly impair its authority to make decisions in the best interest of district students or its ability or commitment to provide equitable educational opportunities.

4. Imply endorsement of any business or product or unduly commercialize or politicize the school environment

consider whether the gift:

- 1. Has a purpose consistent with the district's vision and philosophy
- 2. Begins a program which the Board would be unable to continue when the donated funds are exhausted
- 3. Entails undesirable or excessive costs
- 4. Implies endorsement of any business or product

The Board shall carefully evaluate any conditions or restrictions imposed by the donor in light of district philosophy and operations. If the Board feels the district will be unable to fully satisfy the donor's conditions, the gift shall not be accepted.

Appreciation

The Board may show appreciation for any donation to the district in any manner it deems appropriate. Such appreciation may take the form of letters of recognition or Board resolutions; plaques, commendations, or awards; planting of commemorative trees or gardens; or naming or renaming of buildings, grounds, or facilities. Conferment of any such honor shall be in accordance with applicable Board policy.

- 4. The authority of the Board to terminate the agreement without any penalty or sanction to the district if the sponsor's message, bussiner product becomes inconsistent with district vision, mission, or goals or the sponsor engages in any prohibited activity.
- 5. The prohibition against the collection of students' personal information except as allowed by law.
