




Individualized Analysis of Student Academic Data to Identify College Eligibility Matches for each Sac City Unified 12th grade Student








SCUSD College Application Fee Waiver

- In response to our Students' advocacy efforts, we are making available funds to subsidize the cost of one four-year college application fee up to \$100 for every eligible 12th grade student.
- " Status as of 11/15/22
 - 120 students have made a request
 - 51 students have received CSÜ college waivers
 - 27 students have registered for reimbursement for a UC or a




