FEBRUARY 15 No change to school masking requirement




School Masking still required

## Sacramento County COVID-19 Case Rates




Omicron variant spread widely in Sacramento County 36.3 cases per 100k residents 33.9% positivity rate last week










#### **COVID-19 Student Vaccination Status Dashboard**






