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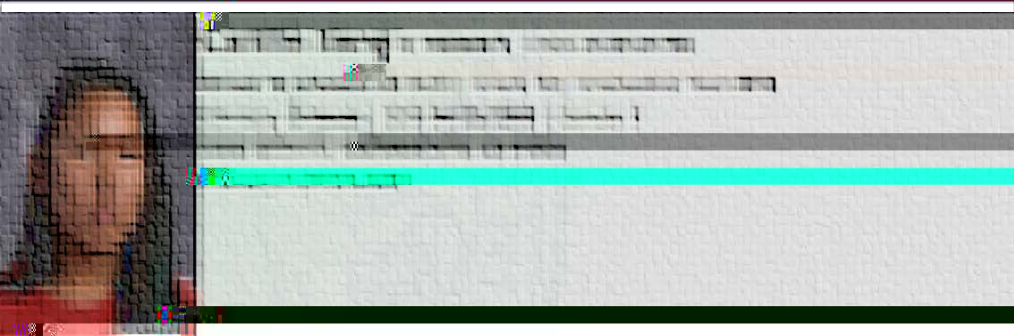
Individualized Analysis of Student Academic Data to Identify College Eligibility Matches for each Sac City Unified 12th grade Student

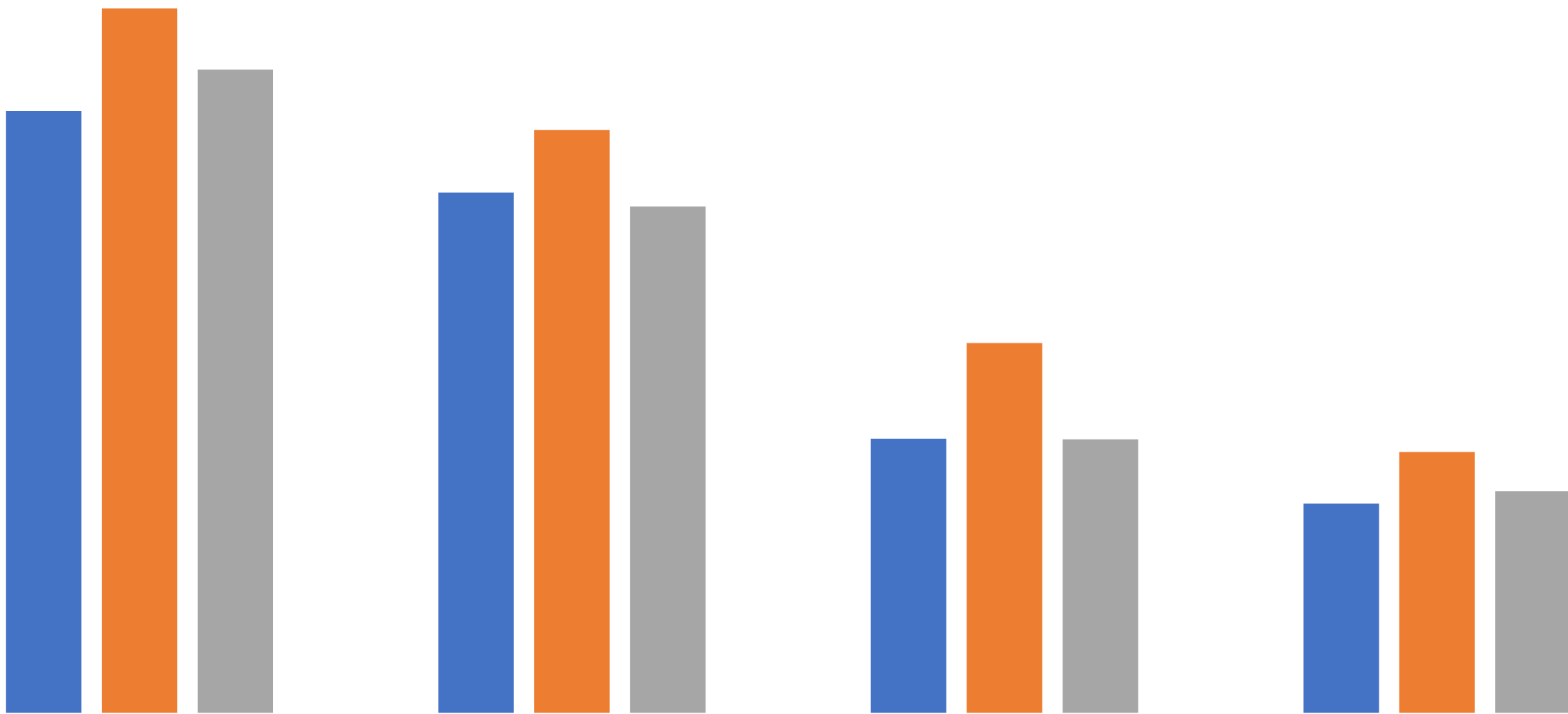

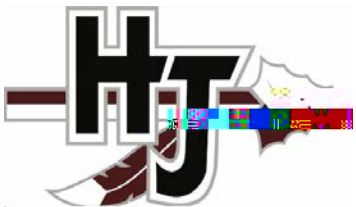
Supports during the day

EAOP: Help more students meet requirements for college. In addition, they provide weekly academic advising. (120 Students 9th-12th Graders)

Cal-Soap: Provides tutoring services to students and delivery college and financial aid advising. (All Seniors and Juniors)

College Track: College Track is a free college completion program that empowers students to graduate from a 4 year college. Student recruitment begins in 9th grade

Jr RISE: College preparation and retention program, starting with 11th and 12th grade and extends to 1st year in college (Every Tuesday and Thursdays)
