FCMAT Fiscal Healthisk Analysis

- FCMAT worked out of Serna between Monday, October 15, 2018 and Wednesday, October 18, 2018
- Interviewed Superintendent, all cabinet members, as well as heads of each department, including HR, Facilities, Transportation, Payroll, Financial Services
- FCMAT Fiscaled Ith Risk Analysis focuses on common indicators for risk of insolvency, ot specific reductions to eliminate the ficit
- Anticipated completion of FCMAT Fiscal Health Analysis is December 2018

Budget Review Committees. Waiver ofBudget Review Committee

- With budget disapproval, the Sacramento Countyperintendent must call for the formation of a Budget Review Committendess the governing board of the district and the County Superintendent agree to waive this requirement.
- Waiver must be approved by District Board and submittethe County Superintendent for approval.
- California Department of Education (CDE) must approve the Waiver.

Budget Review Committee vs. Waiver BudgetReview Committee

- Budget Review Committee (BRC)
 - Pros
 - One of two options the Board can consider
 - Cons
 - Not common practice with the CDE, i.e. CDE does not have an existing Budget Review Committee list a would have to form one
 - Budget Review Committee has a very short timeline, thus not allowing the District to capitalize on ability work with labor partner and other stakeholders between now the December 14, 2018 First Interim Report and Balanced Budget deadline
 - Ed Code does not require that we have access to the SCOE

Recommendation is for Board to approve the Waive of the Budget Review Committee
