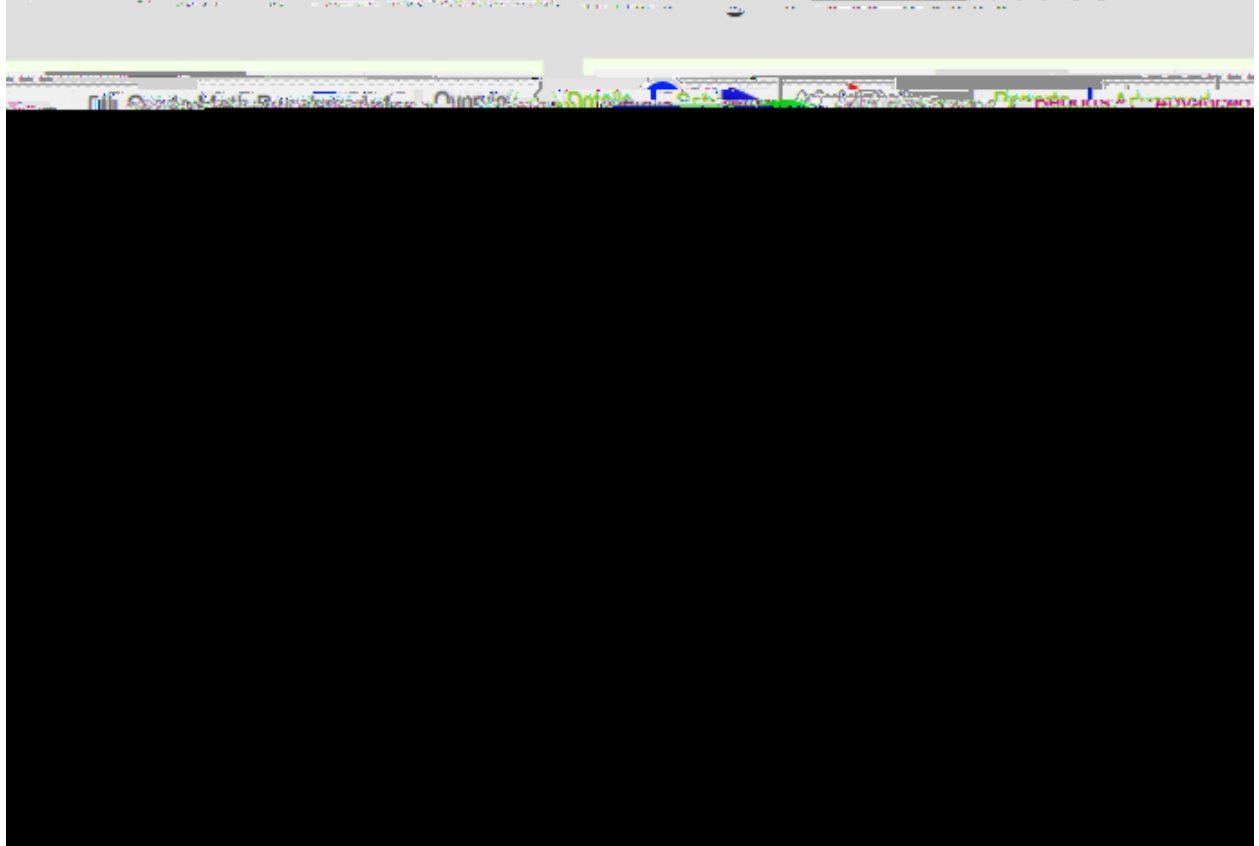

1. Click on the # under students to access the students you wish to enable Text to Speech for.



What will this look like?



When a student is viewing a question on a test and is equipped with Text to Speech, they will see the text to speech tool bar at the top of both the Passage and Question. Play is to play the passage or question. Pause will pause the reader and Stop will stop the reader. Students can play the passage or question as many times as they wish.
