ARTICLE 20. RATIFICATION BY BOARD OF E DUCATION.

Pursuant to the provisions of Education Code section 39656, SCUSD Board Regulation BP-3312 and SCUSD Board Resolution 2590, this Agreement is not enforceable and is invalid unless and until it is approved and/or ratified by the governing board of the Sacramento City Unified School District, as evidenced by a motion of said board duly passed and adopted.

Amendment No. 1 extends the current agreement from July 10, 2011 to July 9, 2012 (Year 4) and increases amount by \$370,700.73. Amendment No. 1 also accepts the appointment of Dr. Joanne Bookmyer and Arthur Beauchamp as the Co-Principle Investigators for this Agreement. All other terms of the original agreement entered into on November 6, 2008, shall remain in full force and effect.




