The ethnic, age group and socioeconomic composition of the district The business community, such as store owners, managers or supervisors Landowners or renters, with preference to be given to representatives of neighborhood associations Teachers Administrators Parents of students Persons with expertise in environmental impact, legal contracts, building codes and land use planning, including, but not limited to, knowledge of the zoning and other land use restrictions of the cities or cities and counties in which surplus space and real property is located.
