





Choice and Commitment






CST Results

CST Results (2007-11)


Percent of Students Proficient or Advanced

Total 8-Year Gain (2002-03 to 2010-11) = 218 points






State vs.Sac High API

2010* SAT/ACT Participation


77% of the Class of 2011 took the SAT and 87% took the ACT




Overall AP Pass Rates: 2007 - 2011
